You must be enrolled with a minimum of 6 EOU credits at EOU to be eligible for any fee remissions or scholarships from EOU (e.g. University Scholar, etc.). You must be taking a minimum of 12 EOU credits to be eligible for EOU Foundation scholarships. Failure to register for 12 EOU credits during fall term may revoke your Foundation Scholarships for the year.

IMPORTANT: Because you must be taking at least 1 credit from EOU each term to get financial aid from EOU, you will likely need to switch your home school to OSU at some point in your junior or senior year to continue to get financial aid. Once there are no more EOU classes that you can take towards degree completion, work with the Office of Financial Aid at OSU (541-737-2241) to get your aid switched.

1. Add OSU to your FAFSA at fafsa.gov (*add both EOU and OSU for your junior and/or senior years*).
2. Submit an enrollment revision and loan revision request form to EOU's Financial Aid Office (FAO) canceling aid for the terms you won't be getting financial aid from EOU.
3. Submit a new consortium agreement form to EOU's FAO declining future aid.
4. Accept your aid from OSU and complete any requirements on your OSU account. Revise your loan period if switching mid-year. Let OSU's Office of Financial Aid know that you want OSU to be your home school.

Release of Information:
